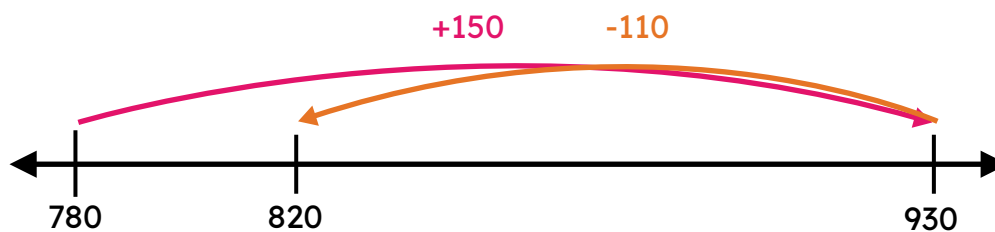
Instruction

Remember, move right on the number line to add. Move left on the number line to subtract.



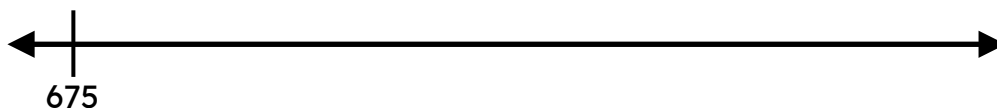
There are 820 rolls left in the bakery.
